## Re: ITF Seniors Circuit – 2016 Rule Changes

I would like to take this opportunity at the close of the 2015 season to let you know about some important rule changes coming into effect on the ITF Senior Circuit in 2016:

<u>World Individual Championships, Grade A, Regional Closed Championships – Abbreviations</u> In 2016, the following abbreviations will be used (historically and present):

World Individual Championships Formally known as Grade A, will be abbreviated to 'WC'

New Grade A Tournaments Will be abbreviated to Grade 'A'

**Regional Closed Championships** Formally known as Grades B1-B3, will be abbreviated to

'RC1-RC3'

## Seeding

The number of seeds in Singles events will be amended in order to maintain consistency with other ITF events. The number of seeds shall be as follows:

For a draw of 128: 32 seeds For a draw of 96: 32 seeds For a draw of 64: 16 seeds For a draw of 48: 16 seeds For a draw of 32: 8 seeds For a draw of 24: 8 seeds For a draw of 16: 4 seeds For a draw of 8: 2 seeds

## Round Robin - 5 Players only

If there are 5 players in a draw and the tournament lasts less than five days, a knock-out draw can be approved instead of a round robin format. If a knock-out draw is played, a consolation event is strongly recommended.
